

How to make a script

- First, before you start writing your script, take a few minutes with your team to look over the project, robot, and core values rubrics. This will give your team an idea of all the requirements for what you want to accomplish.
- Your team's project script may be fun, for example, the project the Cyber Turtles created for the Superpowered Season, was a school curriculum, so the project script was based on a classroom setting. The project script may also just simply state the facts. Your robot script should just state the facts, maybe add a few funny puns to keep it fun.
- 3. Next, If you are creating a fun script for your project script, come up with a general theme revolving around the FLL theme for that season, and your project and solution. Some ideas are a infomercial, commercial, fun story or skit.

Scripts should...

- Tie into the season theme- try to relate the setting, characters, and other elements of your script
- Start of by stating your project problem statement or robot mission strategy
- Include LOTS of important statistics and data, such as number of experts, research and testing- try to include the name of the expert if they are the ones who told you that statistic
- Be easy to follow along and understand
- Include names of experts interviewed
- Include feedback given by experts
- Include important and unique features of your robot
- Try to list all information in rubric order things such as mission statement and contacted experts
